

The Division is offering a training seminar as an overview of the cohesion needed between plain clothes officers and Field Force personnel during a violent protest or civil unrest. This seminar is designed for plain clothes detectives, Field Force personnel, and supervisors.

The seminar will provide insight and lessons learned from the World Trade Organization (WTO) protests in Seattle. Questions are encouraged and will be answered by the instructor, a 32 year veteran detective who was on the front line during the now infamous "Battle for Seattle." The detective also worked undercover, successfully infiltrating numerous violent groups. He is considered one of the foremost instructors of undercover operatives in the United States and abroad.
